Principal Update

New Business/Request for Funds

- Family Bingo Night update given by Janelle: is this Friday, 5/12. A lot of great donations by community businesses. Janelle encouraged everyone to reach out to all business in community, giving State Farm as a typically unlikely donor, however they provided large donation basket this year!
- Voting was held for the 2017-2018 PTSO Board. Discussion amongst guests, Danielle Mowry was interested in the position of Secretary but was unsure if current Secretary was running again. Janelle confirmed is seeking this position for the upcoming year. Courtney Kruezweisner has chosen not to run for re-election for Communications Coordinator, she would like to assist board in building relationships with community, recruiting more involvement and Spirit Wear project. Mandy Burris has chosen not to run for re-election for Fundraising Coordinator but will continue to assist board and is open to a Committee position. Remaining current PTSO Board members confirmed seeking re-election for current positions. Danielle Mowry added her name to Fundraising Coordinator. - a) PUPC update from Nicole Friedl: Peoria Chief of Police spoke at last meeting on March 31st. He shared information about Lunch with Blue visits at campuses, officers visiting campuses, Shop with a Cop program which partners with Kohl's, the Repeat Offender Program, Youth Citizen Police Academy coming in summer, S.W.A.G. award (Students with Aspiring Goals). Police officer present on all high school campuses: this presence is appreciated by school staff. Discussed that Fire Drills are practices every month, but Lockdown drill only twice a year, would like to see that practices more often due to increased incidents requiring Lockdowns at campuses district wide. The Bond Committee is in place – next meeting is this Thursday, 5/11, at 6pm at the D.A.C. Superintendent Stiffler did Q&A session at meeting: discussed land purchases, how to handle vacancies, he event stayed late to answer more questions once meeting ended.
- b) Courtney gave Spirit Wear update: trialing shirts with Christy Martin of Younique Impressions. Trying to keep costs low and manage the inventory for initial product. Janelle suggested sweatshirt for fall. Ms. McCarty will be working with StuCo in helping the Spirit Wear process. Could be available at Meet the Teacher to help take orders and assist Mrs. Martin.
- c) Next Meeting will be held during the fall on 2017. Information will be posted on the website.
